We have constructed this letter to serve as an introduction to our ministry, The International Association for Creation. The International Association for Creation is a nonprofit corporation, recognized by the state of Florida as a religious, charitable organization; further recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a section 501(c)(3) public charity. All donations to the ministry are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law. The ministry was organized as an independent non-profit organization in September 2016.

As a recognized 501(c)(3) charitable organization, The International Association for Creation is bound by the rules and regulatory requirements as set forth by the law. Primary oversight of our organization has been entrusted to our Board of Directors, which consists of six members. The Board of Directors is charged with making all decisions regarding major purchases and expenditures, salaries of officers, and shifts in ministerial direction. The board, with its independent make up majority, helps maintain a necessary measure of accountability. Day-to-day operational decisions are handled by the in-house board, consisting of the President, Executive Vice President, various Department Managers.

Our desire is to be as financially transparent as possible. To that end, as required, our federal 990 tax filings will become available for public inspection upon request. We are actively pursuing membership with the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability (ECFA), and our annual financial statement audits will be done by an outside accounting firm.

Our mission is to work with biblical creation museums and ministries around the world to credibly present the historical authenticity of Genesis, affirm the faith of Christians, and declare the salvation message to the lost. As we endeavor to unify creation museums and ministries, we seek to provide them with strategic guidance for tactically presenting biblical creation evidence and debunking evolution.

All gifts received and/or funds generated from the sale of any resource goes directly back into the funding of the ministry's vision, mission, initiatives, goals and objectives. As mentioned, the Board serves as the guardian to ensure that this is the case, as they have oversight on all salary and contract agreements. The leaders of the ministry continually seek the Lord when considering new ways to fulfill the mission entrusted to us. As the Lord direct and provides, we follow.
